INTRODUCTION

LeaderTrack provides development pathways for those wanting to be equipped for leadership in a local church.

Combining practical, relational and academic aspects, participants are given skills in ministry planning, building teams, and strategy. They also grow in self-leadership and spiritual formation through the various learning pathway options and supervision.

Cohorted learning is involved in most streams with students from throughout Qld joining for various events throughout the course of the year.

There are Under-graduate Certificate and Diploma awards available through Australian College of Ministries (ACOM), with fee-help available for those units. Other fees related to non-academic elements of LeaderTrack are payable separately.

Other compulsory modules and experiences are added throughout the 1st year. These include ACOM facilitations; onsite residentials and weekend retreats.

WHO IS THIS PATHWAY SUITED TO

Interns

For those dedicating one or two years to an immersion experience at their local church, LeaderTrack offers a cohorted journey. Participants can choose to include Certificate or Diploma studies if they wish to seek qualification awards from their pathway, or else undertake the Formation Year as their primary learning journey.

Ministry Leaders

For those who lead programs and teams in their local church. LeaderTrack can be undertaken on a part-time basis.


WHO IS CONNEXA COLLEGE

At a glance




Participants can opt for an awarded Undergraduate Cert. stream through ACOM or <u>Formation Year</u> for their pathway.

- Note 1 Retreats are a short weekend onsite at Kenmore campus.
- Note 2 Residentials are a mid-week, multi-day workshop experience at Kenmore campus.
- Note 3 Accommodation costs for retreats and residentials not included.
- Note 3 XCC & Arise are special character challenge experiences facilitated by 4MAUS

- **Note 1** If participants have undertaken Formation Year in year one, they can commence Cert.Min, as an academic stream for year 2.
- Note 2 If participants have undertaken Cert.Min. for year 1, they can complete Dip. Min. in year 2.

OUR ACADEMIC PROVIDER



Pathways with awards are provided in partnership with the <u>Australian College of Ministries</u> (ACOM). ACOM is a Member Institute of the <u>Sydney College of Divinity</u> who offer internationally recognised higher education awards.

ACOM Units and pathways are to be applied for via the ACOM website.

FORMAT

Non-ACOM and Compulsory Units

Various modules are produced by ConneXa College. These include content that is printed or available online in PDF, audio or video format.

For the <u>Leaders who S.E.R.V.E.</u> module there are two ½ day workshops to help participants apply and understand the content.

For those undertaking the <u>Formation Year</u> pathway, check the **Pathway Overview** – **Formation Year** booklet for more detail.

ACOM Units

All unit content is available through the ACOM Moodle system.

ACOM Facilitations

Most ACOM units include some Facilitation days where content topics are discussed. These will usually take place at Kenmore Church campus in Brisbane. Accommodation for theses periods is not included in registrations.

Residentials

Two residentials are held each year onsite at Kenmore Campus (<u>check dates online</u>). Year 1 (2023) residentials are as follows:

Residential 1 - Life with God.

3 days. Topics include: Christian identity; Life with the Spirit; Living with Form and Freedom. Check dates online.

Residential 2 - Leading people.

3 days. Topics include: Defining leadership; Working in teams; Communication; and more. Check dates online.

Accommodation not included in registration.

Character Challenge

In September/October of year 1 participants engage in a **Character challenge**. XCC (men) – Arise (women) facilitated by 4th Musketeer Australia. Participants can choose to opt-out of this challenge with a refund given, but we encourage each person to participate in a great and challenging few days and nights with a group of others.
